

## Fire Department Equipment

View pictures and learn about the Federal Heights Fire Department trucks.

Engine 41 is a 1992 Seagrave "pumper". It carries 750 gallons of water and has a 1250 gallons per minute pump capacity. It is also equipped with advanced life support medical equipment.

Truck 43 is a 2001 Smeal/Spartan "quint". It serves as both a pumper and an aerial apparatus. It has a 500 gallon water tank, a 1500 gallons per minute pump, and a 75 foot aerial ladder with a full length piped waterway. It is also equipped with advanced life support medical equipment.

Medic 44 is a 2005 Ford F-450 Wheeled Coach advanced life support ambulance with four-wheel drive and equipment to support rescue and firefighting activities.

Medic 45 is a 1999 Ford McCoy Miller advanced life support ambulance with equipment to support rescue and firefighting activities.

Squad 46 is a 1992 International Brush and Special Operations unit equipped with a 90 GPM pump and a 250 gallon water tank. This vehicle carries specialized equipment for technical rescue, hazardous materials operations, and fire investigation.
